

Privacy Policy

Centrum e-Zdrowia attaches particular importance to respecting the privacy of users visiting the website (www.cez.gov.pl) administered by CeZ. Data collected in log journals are used only for the purposes of the website administration. All data of users obtained through the website are intended solely for the use of CeZ.

Administering the website

All activities related to the functioning of the website www.cez.gov.pl, CeZ undertakes through its organizational units.

Identity of the controller

The controller of your data is Centrum e-Zdrowia, with its registered office in Warsaw (00-184) at ul. Stanisława Dubois 5A

Contact details of the controller

Centrum e-Zdrowia has appointed a data protection officer, who you can contact via email iod@cez.gov.pl. The data protection officer can be contacted in all matters related to the processing of personal data and exercise of the rights related to the processing of data.

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Purposes of processing, grounds for processing and scope of processed data

All data from users of the website www.cez.gov.pl are collected in two ways:

- information provided voluntarily by the user:
Receiving the Newsletter requires the provision, in the relevant form, of an email address and giving consent to the processing of personal data to the extent necessary to provide the services related to the transmission of the Newsletter. Data obtained in this way are added to the Newsletter's mailing list. The provision of data is always voluntary. Each of the Newsletter's registered users has the right, at any time, to change or delete their data from our database – to do this it is necessary to click the appropriate link at the bottom of the page in the received Newsletter.
- information obtained during the use of the websites – these may include:
 - a. information in servers logs – our servers automatically record such data as a page request sent by the user, date and time of the request and sending a response, data of the device (e.g. hardware model), browser type, browser language, operating system type,
 - b. IP address – every computer connected to the Internet has an assigned unique number, that is the IP address; on its basis it is possible e.g. to identify the country from which a given user connects to the Internet,
 - c. text files ("cookies") sent to the user's computer when visiting the website.
- Data are processed in order to:
pursue a legitimate interest of the Controller (Art. 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR), consisting in the marketing of our products and services, and in the case of express consent – also the products and services of companies cooperating with the Controller (Art. 6 (1) (a) of the GDPR), using the following forms of communication:
newsletter (sending of an information bulletin), in order to fulfill obligations arising from legal provisions (Art. 6 (1) (c) of the GDPR).
- Also in connection with the pursuit of other legitimate interests of the Controller (Art. 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR):
in order to establish, pursue and defend claims, for statistical purposes, related to the improvement of work efficiency, the quality of provided services and their adaptation to the recipients.

Recipients of data

Your personal data may be made available and transmitted to public administration bodies, services, courts and public prosecutor's office.

Information on the processing of personal data on the websites

Cookie files

The website collects automatically only information contained in cookie files. The website operator informs that cookie files (the so-called "cookies") are information technology data, in particular text files, which are stored on the Website's User terminal device. Cookie usually contain the name of the website from which they originate, their storage time on the terminal device and a unique number.

Cookie files are used in order to:

- adapt the content of the Website's pages to the user's preferences and optimize the use of the websites; in particular these files allow to recognize the website's user's device and properly display the website, tailored to their individual needs;
- create statistics, which allow to understand in what way the Website's users use the pages, which allow to improve their structure and content maintain the website's user's session;

The Website uses the following types of cookie files:

- "necessary" cookie files, allowing the use of services available within the website, e.g. authentication cookie files used for services that require authentication within the Website; cookie files used to ensure safety, e.g. used to detect abuses in terms authentication within the Website;
- "performance" cookie files that allow the collection of information on the way the Website's pages are used;
- "functional" cookie files that allow the "remembering" of the settings chosen by the User and personalization of the User's interface, e.g. in terms of the selected language or region from which the User comes from, font size, page appearance etc.;

Web browsers (website's user's software) by default allow the storing in the terminal device of cookie files, the website's User may always change the web browser's settings determining the use of cookie files. Restrictions on the use of cookie files may affect the functionality of the Website. Cookie files placed in the terminal device of the Service User may also be used by advertisers and partners cooperating with the service operator. The service operator informs that the entity responsible for the placing of cookie files in the terminal device of the service user at the same time having access to them is the Controller. The Controller informs that information on the methods of handling cookies is available in the software (web browser) settings. More information about cookie files is available in the "help" section in the menu of your web browser.

Each user, who does not consent to the use of cookie files is obliged to modify the web browser settings. The configuration of the system enabling the use of cookie files signifies your agreement to the storage by the Controller of information referred to above, pursuant to Art. 173 (2) of the Act of 16 July 2004 Telecommunications Law (OJ of 2021 item 576 as amended).

Change of Cookie files storing and receipt conditions is possible by changing the settings of your web browser:

- In the Internet Explorer web browser
- In the Mozilla Firefox web browser
- In the Chrome web browser
- In the Safari web browser
- In the Opera web browser

Due to their storage period, cookie files are divided into session and persistent cookies. Session cookies are stored on the user's device until logging out from the website or turning off the web browser. Persistent files are stored for a defined time, which is determined by the parameter contained in a "cookie" file. Typically, it ranges from 1 day to 2 years, whereby some cookie files may remember the user's settings until the history is deleted. The user has the possibility to manually delete all or selected cookie files, according to the options provided by the web browser or related tools.

Google Analytics, Google Optimize and Google Tag Manager

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service made available by Google Ireland Limited (below: Google). Google Analytics uses cookie files. The information generated by the cookie on the use of this website is usually sent to a Google server in the USA and stored there. However, due to the activation of IP anonymization on these websites, your IP address will be truncated by Google beforehand within Member States of the European Union or other countries parties to the Agreement on the European Economic Area. Only in exceptional cases will the full IP address be sent to a Google server in the USA and truncated there. On behalf of the operator of this website Google will use this information to evaluate the use of the website by the user, to compile reports on the activity on the website and to provide other services related to the website traffic and the use of the Internet for the operator of the website. Your IP address made available by Google Analytics will not be combined with other data held by Google.

The purpose of the processing of data is the evaluation of the use of the website and the compilation of reports on the activities on the website. Based on the use of the website and the Internet other related services will be provided. Processing is based on the legitimate interest of the website operator.

Google Analytics collects data on IP addresses, network location, date of visit, operating system, browser type. You can disable the storing of cookie files using the appropriate setting of your browser; however, you should remember that, if you do this, you may not be able to use all features of this website to the fullest extent possible.

In addition, you can disable the collection by Google of data generated by cookie files and data related to the use of the website (including your IP address), as well as the processing of these data by Google by downloading and installing the browser plug-in available under the following link: [Browser Add On](#) in order to disable Google Analytics. Alternatively or as an alternative to the browser add-on, you can prevent the tracking by Google Analytics on our websites, by clicking on this link. An opt-out cookie will be installed on your device. This will prevent the collection by Google Analytics for this website and for this browser in the future, if the cookie file remains installed in the browser.

Transmission of personal data to a third country or international organization

Your personal data, in principle, will not be transferred outside the European Economic Area (hereinafter: EEA). However, bearing in mind services provided by subcontractors of the Controller in the implementation of support for IT services and infrastructure, the Controller may order the performance of specific activities or IT tasks to recognized subcontractors operating outside the EEA which may result in the transfer of your data outside the EEA area.

Recipient countries from outside the EEA, in accordance with the decision of the European Commission ensure an adequate level of personal data protection in compliance with the EEA standards. In the case of recipients in the territory of Countries not covered by the decision of the European Commission, in order to ensure an adequate level of this protection, the Controller concludes agreements with the recipients of your personal data, on the basis of standard contractual clauses issued by the European Commission pursuant to Art. 46 (2) (c) of the GDPR.

The method of securing your data used by the Controller complies with the principles provided for in Chapter V of the GDPR. You may request further information on the safeguards used in this regard, obtain a copy of these safeguards and the information on the place where they are available.

Data retention period

Your personal data will be stored until consent is withdrawn or objection raised, i.e. showing us in withdrawal of consent or not wish to remain in touch with us and receive information on activities undertaken by us. After with withdrawal of consent or raising objection, your personal data may be stored for the purposes of demonstrating the correctness of compliance with legal obligations incumbent on the Controller or until the expiry of the limitation periods for claims, whichever time period is longer. In the event of the conclusion of an agreement (e.g. as regards provision of services by electronic means) with the Controller your personal data will be processed for the duration of the agreement, and if it is justified – until the expiry of the limitation periods for claims resulting from it.

Rights of data subjects

You have the right to access your data and the right to demand their rectification and deletion.

Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority dealing with the protection of personal data in the Member State of your habitual residence, work place or place of committing an alleged breach.
